Your 2022 Summary Annual Reports

The Summary Annual Reports (SARs) for the Siemens Medical Solutions USA, Inc. Savings Plan and the Siemens Medical Solutions USA, Inc. Group Insurance and Flexible Benefits Program for Plan Year 2022 can be found in this booklet.

Here are answers to some common questions you may have about the SARs.

What is a Summary Annual Report (SAR)?

A SAR provides brief financial information about an employee benefit plan. It is a summary of the plan's annual report, which is a much longer and more detailed document. The SAR includes such information as:

- The amount of benefits paid under the plan;
- Plan expenses; and
- Number of participants

In addition, if applicable, the SAR includes information such as:

- The value of plan assets at year-end compared with the value of plan assets at the beginning of the year;
- Total income for the plan; and
- Insurance information

Why does Siemens Healthineers provide this document?

For certain types of plans, companies are legally required to file an annual report with the Department of Labor each year and to provide a SAR to plan participants and beneficiaries receiving benefits under the plan.

What benefit plans are covered by the SARs provided by Siemens Medical Solutions USA, Inc.?

A SAR is provided for each savings and health and welfare plan which Siemens Medical Solutions USA, Inc. sponsors. If you participate in a pension plan, similar information is provided to you in an annual funding notice each April.

What if I want more information than what is provided in a SAR?

For any plan for which there is a SAR, you can request that a copy of the complete annual report be mailed to you. (You will have to pay copying costs for the annual report. The cost for copying the complete annual report for the Siemens Medical Solutions USA, Inc. Savings Plan is \$10.75 and the Siemens Medical Solutions USA, Inc. Group Insurance and Flexible Benefits Program is \$10.75.) SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

For Siemens Medical Solutions USA, Inc. Savings Plan

This is a summary of the annual report for the Siemens Medical Solutions USA, Inc. Savings Plan, EIN 22-2417778, Plan Number 002 for the plan year January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided by a trust fund. Plan expenses were \$380,677,089. These expenses included \$380,579,334 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, and \$97,755 in other expenses. A total of 20,626 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$5,103,220,786 as of the end of the plan year, compared to \$6,083,077,546 as of the beginning of the plan year. During the plan year the plan experienced a change in its net assets of \$979,856,760. This change includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of (\$599,179,671), including employer contributions of \$117,377,201, employee contributions of \$172,720,125, other (including rollovers) of \$14,705,069 and earnings from investments of (\$903,982,066).

This is a summary of the annual report of the Siemens Medical Solutions USA, Inc. Group Insurance and Flexible Benefits Program, EIN 22-2417778, Plan Number 565, for the plan year January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Siemens Medical Solutions USA, Inc. has committed itself to pay certain health, dental, vision and all temporary disability claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has insurance contracts with Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company, EyeMed, Hartford Life and Accident, Hawaii Medical Service Association, Life Insurance Company of North America, Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company and Affiliates (Cigna), Kaiser Foundation Health Plan Inc and Lincoln National Life Insurance Company to pay certain health, dental and vision and all life insurance, long-term disability, death benefits and accidental death and dismemberment claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2022 were \$19,714,065.

Your Rights to Additional Information

You have the right to receive a copy of the full annual report, or any part thereof, on request. The items listed below are included, as applicable, in that report:

- an accountant's report;
- assets held for investment;
- insurance information, including sales commissions paid by insurance carriers; and
- information regarding any common or collective trusts, pooled separate accounts, master trusts or 103-12 investment entities in which the plan participates.

To obtain a copy of the full annual report, or any part thereof, write or call the office of Siemens Healthineers, at 40 Liberty Boulevard, Malvern, PA 19355, and phone number, 1-833-533-2450.

You also have the right to receive from the plan administrator, on request and at no charge, a statement of the assets and liabilities of the plan, as applicable, and accompanying notes, or a statement of income and expenses of the plan and accompanying notes, or both. If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, if applicable, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan: Siemens Healthineers, Inc, at 40 Liberty Boulevard, Malvern, PA 19355, and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs. Paperwork Reduction Act Statement

According to the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995 (Pub. L. 104-13) (PRA), no persons are required to respond to a collection of information unless such collection displays a valid Office of Management and Budget (OMB) control number.
